Extract of Curriculum Vitae



Italian nationality. *Born* in Bologna on 22 October 1948 and resident in Bologna at via Porrettana 34 – 40135, Bologna. He *graduated* in Medicine and Surgery at the University of Bologna in Academic Year 1975-76; attaining 3 *Specializations* in Internal Medicine, Diseases of the Digestive System and Sports Medicine in the 80s and 90s; passed two national examinations of skills as Director of Gastroenterology and Internal Medicine Clinical Units in the early 1990s. He spent *around twenty years as a university employee*, at the Policlinico Sant'Orsola in Bologna and around *twenty years as a hospital employee* at for the National Health Service in Bologna.

Academic Activity. During the university period (1980s-1990s) his role was *University Researcher* for the Internal Medicine group. In that period he was elected to represent the researchers for the Faculty and on the Presidency Council of Medicine and Surgery where he was a member of numerous committees (Specialization Schools, Relations between University and NHS, Staff training). From 1987-1990 he was on the Board of Directors of the University of Bologna.

Clinical Activity. During his employment with the university he carried out clinical activities, as an *Internist* and as a *Clinical Researcher* at the Medical Pathology I and Clinical Medicine I Departments of the Policlinico Sant'Orsola in Bologna. During the NHS period (from 1 September 1998 to 3 March 2016) he was *Director of the Internal* Medicine A Clinical Unit at the Ospedale Maggiore in Bologna and of the <u>Centre for Research and Training in Internist, Interventional and Vascular Ultrasound (US)</u>. From August 2003 to October 2005 he also acted as *Departmental Head of* Medical-Surgical Gastroenterology and from 2006 to 2016 he was *Coordinator of the Medical Area Centre* of the NHS Medical Department of Bologna, comprising 4 Clinical Units of Internal Medicine, Endocrinology and Dermatology. In the two-year period 2014 – 2015, in addition to heading Medicine A and the US Centre, he also took over the role of Director of *Internal Medicine OB* at the Ospedale Bellaria and of *Dermatology*.

Didactic-Training Activities consisted, during the university period, of numerous *teaching posts* at the Faculty of Medicine and Surgery and the Specialization Schools at the University of Bologna. Subsequently, during the hospital period, he taught as a *Contract Professor* in "Medical Oncology" in the three-year degree course for Qualified Nurses until 2009; in "Functional and Instrumental Semeiotics" in the Specialization School in Sports Medicine until 2008, at the University of Bologna. He also taught "Gastroenterology - Physiopathology" until 2005; Internal Medicine (2nd Year) until 2009 and "Internist Semeiotics in Gastroenterology" in 2013-15, at the Specialization School in Gastroenterology at the Rome branch, Policlinico "A. Gemelli", of the Sacred Heart Catholic University. From 2010 to 2016 he was *Lecturer in the University Master's Degree* in Level II Internist US at the La Sapienza University in Rome (Dir. Prof. F. Violi). From 2005 to 2017 he organized the annual "Summer School" in US for the Italian Society of Internal Medicine (SIMI) and was national training manager of the US Study Group and of the Bedside US network of the SIMI Schools (www.simi.it).

Scientific Activity. The fields of most interest in scientific activity concerned both *clinical aspects* (studies in gastroenterological physiopathology, inflammatory and neoplastic diseases of the digestive tract and the liver, clinical, internist and interventional ultrasound) and *health organization aspects* (Accreditation, Plan for Local Implementation of Internal Medicine in the Province of Bologna, Management of hospital admissions, Overcrowding in hospitals, Organization of hospitals according to intensity of care). He was a *member of the Regional Observatory for the Specialization Schools* in Medicine of Emilia Romagna. He was a member of the *Executive Councils* of the Italian Society of Ultrasound in Medicine and Biology (SIUMB) and of the Italian Society of Internal Medicine (SIMI), of the *Scientific Committee* of MED3 and of the Master's course in Ultrasound at the La Sapienza University. He was *Web-site Editor* of the sites of the above-mentioned scientific societies, SIUMB and SIMI, and *Reviewer* of some international scientific journals. He was President of the SIMI Interregional Emilia-Romagna and Marche Section (2017-2018). His most recent publications focussed on the use of Laser in the treatment of liver cancer and the definition of the Guidelines of the Higher Institute of Health on the diagnosis of tumours of the liver, the position paper of SIMI on the use of Bedside Ultrasound in Internal Medicine, the use of Elastosonography in the diagnosis of focal liver lesions. *Communications, Speaker or Chairman* over 500 times in national and international congresses and training courses. *Author and CoAuthor* of 32 Books, Books chapter, CD rom and VHS.
